## Call for proposals: CrownCom 2011 special sessions

The conference will include special sessions to complement the regular sessions. Prospective Organizers can apply for special sessions of two different sizes: a four-to-six papers special session, or an eight-to-ten one. Each Special Session will be a two-hour long oral session with minimum of four speakers in the first case, and two consecutive two-hour long oral sessions with a minimum of eight speakers in the second case. Special Sessions will be intermixed with regular sessions during the conference. In the Special Session, we would like to invite not only the normal session style, but also a demo session style. So presenters could bring some small testbeds, could share measurements and results, and in some cases could show films of their testbeds.

The proposals for both types of special sessions should include:

- ✓ Title of the special session
- ✓ Names and short CVs of the organizers
- ✓ Summary of the topic
- ✓ Planned invited speakers
- ✓ Planned length

Each proposal, excluding a maximum 4-page CVs of the organizers, should not exceed 10000 characters. Please note that invited speakers as well as organizers and attendees will be required to register for the conference.
