



Call for Workshop Proposals

The CrownCom 2011 Organising Committee invites proposals for workshops to be held with the CrownCom 2011 conference. CrownCom 2011 Workshops provide a forum for discussion among researchers and practitioners of areas of special interest within CrownCom 2011. Within this scope, several types of workshop organisations are encouraged. Workshops are half-day or full-day events, and may be organised by invitation or via an open call for participation. Organisers may invite participants to give talks, or to submit papers with a peer-review process. Organisers will be responsible for advertising the workshop, reviewing and selecting the papers. We plan to publish workshop proceedings with the main conference.

Submission guidelines:

Proposals to organise workshops should include the following information:

- Title of the workshop
- Name, affiliation, mailing address, email address and phone number of the proposer(s)
- Names and affiliations of at least three Programme Committee members for the workshops
- A description of the workshop and topic of interest, and how these relate to the overall conference
- A short description on how the workshop will be advertised so as to ensure a sufficiently wide range of participants
- Planned format of the workshop (half-day/full-day, number of invited talks, peer-reviewed papers, etc)
- A brief introduction of the proposer, explaining his/her qualifications

Workshop proposals deadline: 30th November, 2010

Notification: 15th December, 2010

Papers for workshops should be submitted directly to the Workshop using the CrownCom paper submission system. Deadline for camera-ready submission of workshop papers will be the same as for main-track papers. The Workshop organiser will be required to use the CrownCom paper submission system and to review the papers on basis of the same criteria as those in the main track.
